The Traffic Regulation, Local Law No. 1 of 1977 of the Village of Watkins Glen is hereby amended by the addition of Section 107, HANDICAPPED PARKING to Article X which shall read as follows:

"Section 107. HANDICAPPED PARKING.

The following locations are hereby designated as handicapped parking spots:

- (a) In the Municipal Parking Lot situated east of Franklin Street between 4th and 5th Streets, the parking space located immediately east of the store presently owned and occupied by Eatons five and dime, which is the 8th parking spot north of Fifth Street on the west side of said parking area.
- (b) In the Municipal Parking Lot situated east of Franklin Street on the north side of Third Street, the first parking space in the second row from the west side of said parking lot."

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State.

*Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village or the supervisor of a town, where such officer is vested with power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.
