Pursuant to the powers vested in the Village of Watkins Glen Board of Trustees by Municipal Home Rule Law, Section 10, the said Village Board of Trustees shall have the power to establish, by Resolution, a separate Board of Youth Commissioners, and shall further have the power to alter, by Resolution, the Terms of office of any separate Board of Commissioners from those terms of office as specified in Village Law, Section 3-308.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
