Section 9. B-1 Business Use Districts, Subsection A (5) of Village Ordinance #153, designated as the Village Zoning Ordinance, shall read as follows:

A. USES PERMITTED.

- 5. Hand laundry, personal service laundries, landromats and dry cleaning establishments which conform to the following restrictions: (a) Not more than two dry cleaning units shall be installed, and each such unit shall have a dry load capacity of not more than 50 pounds. (b) No solvent other than a non-inflammable and non-combustible solvent, shall be used.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
