A local law Regulating the Idling of Trains within the Village Limits

Section I. Idling of Train Engines. It shall be unlawful to allow a train diesel engine to idle within the Village limits for more than thirty (30) minutes at a time.

Section II. Penalties. The penalty for violation of this law shall be \$250.00 for the first offense, \$500.00 for the second offense and \$1,000.00 for the third or more offense in an eighteen (18) month period.

Section III. Effective date. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.


