

RECYCLING GUIDE

HELPFUL REMINDERS

- ALL ITEMS CAN BE PLACED IN THE SAME RECYCLING BIN OR TOTE
- All recycling should be no later than 7:00 a.m.
- All recycle containers must be clearly labeled with "R" on all sides.
- Recycle material should NOT be placed in plastic bags with the exception of shredded paper!!

No pick-up on the following Holidays:

- *New Year's Day
- *Memorial Day
- *Independence Day
- *Labor Day
- *Thanksgiving Day
- *Christmas Day



GLASS: Examples include food or beverage bottles and jars, all colors. Cleaned and free of food residue and odors. Remove and discard lids or caps.

NEWSPAPERS AND MAGAZINES: Examples include any newspaper, insert, magazine or catalog.

METAL/ALUMINUM: Examples include any metal food can or aluminum foil.

PLASTIC: Containers with recycle numbers #1 – #7. Examples include yogurt cups, take-out food containers, CD cases and toys items up to the size of a 5 gallon pail.

CARDBOARD: Examples include cardboard with a wavy middle layer (corrugated), cereal and tissue boxes, paper towel rolls and soda carriers. Remove excess tape and labeling. Cut to maximum of 3 ft. x 3 ft. Cardboard should be flattened and tied in bundles no taller than 18 inches high.

OFFICE PAPER AND JUNK MAIL: Examples include advertising flyers, colored or white paper, envelopes, shredded paper (please leave in a plastic bag).

ITEMS THAT ARE NOT RECYCLABLE: Plastic bags or wrapping, window glass, mirrors, styrofoam, light bulbs, dishes, ceramics, paper towels, facial tissue, recyclables still containing food waste, paint, oil, Hazardous material, needles, syringes, VCR tapes, CDs/DVDs, scrap metal, pots, pans, batteries, hard covered books (unless covers are removed), clothing/textiles, wood/lumber, yard trimmings, k-cups, 3-ring/spiral notebooks. Plastic bags can be recycled at participating supermarkets.
