A local law amending Village Ordinance No. 151, Sewer Ordinance for the Village of

That Village Ordinance No. 151, Sewer Ordinance for the Village of Watkins Glen, N. Y., be amended by the change of Section 3 Subdivision (e) thereof in the amount to be charged for sewer rental and in the grouping of consumers by the amount of water used and which amendment will read as follows:

FIRST, that the Village Sewer Ordinance No. 151 be amended by the substitution of a new sewer rate and a new grouping of consumers by amount of water used and which Section 3 Subdivision (e) will read as follows:

(e) The basis for such rental charge shall be as follows: Sewer rental charges shall be assessed against each unit based on the cubic feet of water consumed by said unit on a quarterly basis which charge shall be billed on a quarterly basis as hereinafter defined in paragraph (f). The charge shall be as follows:

0-1000 C.F. Minimum charge	\$20.00
All over 1000 C.F. Per 100 C.F.	.15

SECOND, that this Local Law shall take effect on May 1, 1976.




