It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 21 years to possess, with intent to consume, any alcoholic beverage as defined in Section Three of the New York Alcoholic Beverage Control Law and any amendment thereto, unless such alcoholic beverage has been given by the parent or legal guardian of such person and such person is accompanied by such parent or legal guardian, and provided such possession does not violate any of the provisions of Local Law No. 2 of 1980 (Open Container Law).

II. Violation of this Local Law shall constitute a Violation as defined in the Penal Law of the State of New York, and shall be punishable as such.

III. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
