I. Legislative Intent and Purpose

The intent and purpose of this Local Law are to establish and define the powers of a Youth Commission for the Village of Watkins Glen. The function of such Youth Commission will be to design and coordinate a broad range of youth-oriented activities in order to curb juvenile delinquency, improve the welfare of all youth within the Village and advance the physical, emotional and social welfare of the youth of the community.

II. Composition and Length of Terms

- a) The Mayor shall appoint the members of the Youth Commission, subject to approval of the Board of Trustees.
- b) The Youth Commission shall consist of nine (9) members, at least five (5) of whom shall be residents of the Village. The remaining four (4) members may reside outside of the Village of Watkins Glen, but must reside within the County of Schuyler and the Watkins Glen School District.
- c) Insofar as practicable, membership on the Youth Commission shall be comprised of individuals from diverse socio-economic levels, religious affiliations, races and political persuasions. Both sexes and various age groups should be represented, All members of the Youth Commission shall serve without monetary consideration.
- d) Each member shall be appointed for a two year term.
- e) Vacancies in unexpired terms shall be filled by appointment by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees, and for the remainder of the term of the appointee's predecessor.

- III. Powers, Duties and Responsibilities of the Commission
 - a) Each newly appointed Commission shall elect its own Chairperson.
 - b) Within three months of the adoption of this Local Law and the appointment of the first Commission, the Commission shall draw up and submit to the Mayor and Board of Trustees, a copy of its bylaws and operational guidelines, which are subject to approval by the Board of Trustees. Any future amendments to the by-laws and operational guidelines shall likewise be submitted for review and approval to the Board of Trustees.
 - c) The Chairperson of the Commission will report directly to the Trustees appointed by the Mayor to be liaisons to the Commission on all matters needing the attention of the Board of Trustees and shall report to the Village Parks Department Manager on all youth activities which will be conducted using Parks Department facilities or equipment.
 - d) The Commission shall keep minutes of all meetings of the Commission. All meetings shall be open to the public except as may be authorized by law.
 - e) The Commission will develop, recommend, implement and oversee effective policies, programs, projects and activities for the Youth of the Village of Watkins Glen.
 - f) The Commission will make recommendations to the Mayor and the Board of Trustees relative to budgets, equipment, staffing requirements and personnel selection. Final decisions on these items will be solely the responsibility of the Board.
 - g) The Commission will be primarily responsible for reviewing and analyzing appropriate grants and calling the attention of the Board of Trustees to possibilities for such funding. The Commission will cooperate and assist in the preparation and submission of grant applications.
 - h) The Commission will submit an annual report to the Mayor and Board of Trustees.

IV. Effective Date

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon mailing to the Secretary of State.
