- 1. Local Law No. 6 of 1990 of the Village of Watkins Glen is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2. The riding or use of skateboards, in-line skates, or roller skates within the Village of Watkins Glen is hereby prohibited in the following locations:
  - a. On Franklin Street (State Rte. 14), Fourth Street (State Rte. 414), Decatur Street and on any Village Parking Lot.
  - b. On the sidewalks along Franklin Street and along Fourth Street from one block east of Franklin Street to one block west of Franklin Street.
- 3. In all other areas of the Village of Watkins Glen, the riding or use of skateboards, in-line skates, or roller skates in a reckless manner is hereby prohibited. The term "reckless" shall have the same meaning as defined in the Penal Law of the State of New York, Section 15.05 (3).
- 4. Violation of this Local Law shall be deemed a Violation as defined in the Penal Law of the State of New York and shall be punishable as such, and in addition thereto shall be subject to immediate seizure and forfeiture of the instrumentality (skateboard, in-line skates, or roller skates) used by the alleged violator.

Following a hearing conducted by the Village Board of Trustees, upon written application of the owner of the seized property (skateboard, inline skates, or roller skates), the Board may, in the interests of justice and for good cause shown, return the seized property (skateboard, in-line skates, or roller skates). In the event of final disposition of the charges in favor of the alleged violator, the said seized property (skateboard, in-line skates, or roller skates) shall likewise be returned to its owner.
