A local law	to Prohibit the Storage of Junk Vehicles within the (InserTitale) Village of Watkins Glen
Be it enacte	ed by theBoard of Trustees of the
County City Town Village	of watkins Glen as follows:

- 1. <u>Definition</u>. "Junk Vehicle" is hereby defined as any truck, automobile, truck trailer, snowmobile, motorcycle, ATV, or any other motor vehicle, which is unregistered and no longer intended for, or in condition for, legal use on public highways.
- 2. <u>Junk Vehicles Prohibited</u>. Junk Vehicles, equipment, parts, and other materials or debris associated therewith, shall not be stored in the open areas of any premises within the Village of Watkins Glen, with the following exceptions: a) One unlicensed or unregistered motor vehicle may be stored in the open area of a premises if it is covered by a suitable vehicle cover, in good condition, designed and manufactured for such purpose; and b) Junk Vehicle(s) may be stored in a fully enclosed building or garage.
- 3. <u>Motor Vehicle Repair Shop</u>. This Local Law shall not apply to a licensed motor vehicle repair shop within the Village of Watkins Glen, so long as any Junk Vehicles are maintained at such premises for a reasonable period of time (not exceeding 90 days) prior to sale, repair, removal, or disposal thereof.
- 4. Enforcement and Penalties. Failure of any property owner to remove from his or here premises, any Junk Vehicle, within 10 days after written notice to remove same, served by the Code Enforcement Officer of the Village of Watkins Glen, shall subject the owner to civil liability for the cost of removal (with a minimum charge of \$50.00), and to prosecution of charges as provided in the NYS Penal Law for Violations, and such owner shall be subject to the fines and penalties as prescribed by the Penal Law for Violations.
