Local Law No. 4 of the year 2002

A local law amending and superseding the application of Local Law 4 of the year 1988 relative to SEWER USER RATES and SEWER RENT CHARGE.

Be it enacted by the VILLAGE BOARD of the

Village of WATKINS GLEN as follows:

SECTION 1. It is the legislative intent that the provisions of this Local Law shall supersede, in their entirety, those SEWER USER RATES as established by Local Law 4 of the year 1988.

SECTION 2. SEWER USER RATES, subdivision (b) shall read as follows:

- (b) Sewer user charges shall be assessed against each unit based on the cubic feet of water consumed by said unit on a monthly basis and shall be billed on a monthly basis. The charges shall be as follows:

0-300 Cubic Feet minimum charge per month	\$9.50
Over 300 Cubic Feet per month	\$3.85 per 100 cubic feet

SECTION 3. Sewer Rent Charge will be \$5.00 per month

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF PRIOR LOCAL LAWS OR ORDINANCES

Any prior ordinance or local law of the Village in conflict herewith is hereby repealed except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any Local Law or Ordinance hereby repealed prior to the effective date of this local law.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the Office of the Secretary of the State of New York as provided in Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.




