## APPROVAL OF MINUTES

## Minutes for the Regular Meeting held on November 7, 2023

Trustee Bob Carson made a motion to approve the minutes for the regular Board meeting held on November 7, 2023. Mayor Peter G. Cherock seconded the motion. In further discussion, Trustee Margaret Schimizzi requested that the minutes be amended to note that regarding the PUD public hearing, Julie Symes specifically asked if the developer would be paying for all the electric, water and sewer that would need to be installed and the developer said "yes". The Board then voted on the motion. Trustee Nan Woodworth abstained due to her absence from the 11/07 meeting. All others were in favor. Motion carried.

## Rural Development Loan

Trustee Nan Woodworth made a motion to decline the Rural Development loan (\$2,750,000) and grant (\$500,000) funds for the Water Systems Improvement Project in favor of a NYS EFC funded project. Deputy Mayor Peter G. Cherock seconded the motion. The Board then voted on the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

## Ladder Truck

Request for financing of a new ladder truck was again tabled. Mayor Laurie DeNardo suggested the Fire Dept. liaisons work with the Chief to further plan how to cover the expense and suggested also the possibility of placing the purchase on the March ballot for residents to vote on.

#### Easement

Trustee Nan Woodworth made a motion to approve the municipal utility easement & assignment agreement between the Village and Watkins Brewery Holdings, LLC. Trustee Bob Carson seconded the motion. The Board then voted on the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.
